Charitable Donation Request MIOX Equipment

MIOX strives to do well by doing good. In the aftermath of a disaster, basic needs become paramount; access to safe, sanitary drinking water becomes one of the most critical needs. Indeed, this is one of the most powerful aspects of our technology: the ability to provide safe clean drinking water--anywhere, anytime. Although disasters are truly devastating events, preparation for them is something that can help save resources as well as lives. We're proud to support disaster relief efforts in communities around the world through the use of MIOX equipment.

To be considered for a charitable donation of MIOX equipment, we must have all the information below emailed, faxed, or mailed to MIOX.

Requirements:

1. We need a letter from your organization on your letterhead including:
 - **Name of Organization** (with phone & mailing address)
 - **Name of Contact** (with phone & email)
 - **What equipment is requested.** We offer two types of equipment to aid in such events. The Purifier Pens are hand held devices that can disinfect up to one gallon (four liters) of water. The BPS is a larger unit, disinfecting up to 20,000 gallons (75K liters) per day from most surface water sources. (please contact Maria Sigmon at 505-224-1043 or maria.sigmon@miox.com for assistance in calculating the size of system needed to satisfy your requirements)
 - **When the equipment is needed**
 - **Brief explanation of how your organization will use the MIOX equipment to support its mission.**
2. **VITALLY IMPORTANT:** To qualify for the donation, one to two people from your organization **MUST** be certified operators of the MIOX equipment. This certification requirement may be attained by attending a free 4-hour training class at MIOX.
3. In exchange for the donation of equipment, MIOX requests that your organization provide a testimonial (brief summary and, if possible, pictures) of how the equipment was used and describing the benefit it provided.
4. Provide the location of the equipment after the emergency response. (i.e. Will the equipment be left at the disaster relief site or will it be retained by your organization for future disaster response?)

Please allow at least **5 business days** for your request to be reviewed and a decision to be made. Please note, that providing incomplete information may result in a delay of decision making. We will contact you and let you know whether or not your request has been approved. Thank you for your interest.
